Coffs Harbour Regional Conservatorium is a not-for-profit independent organisation.

Our goal is to enrich the cultural life of the Coffs Harbour community through the provision of quality music education, accessible to all.

Since its formation in 1984, thousands of students have enrolled for lessons, courses and workshops. Many still enjoy music in their lives as a recreational pastime - some have moved into the music industry for their career - all have developed a greater appreciation for, and love of, music.

Students are drawn from a wide geographic area - from Woolgoolga to Nambucca Heads and inland to Bellingen. The music learning programs suit students of all ages, levels of expertise, experience and creative aspiration, across all styles of music.

Like to be involved?

In 2010 the Conservatorium secured its first permanent home, purchasing Lot 1/6A in the Bray Street Complex and completing Stage 1 of the refurbishment. The full range of annual music education programs offered by the Conservatorium now take place in an air-conditioned facility with twelve modern, acoustically engineered studios.

We have come a long way! But there are more rehearsal spaces and a Performance Space yet to be completed.

The 178 seat Performance Space will be used for music rehearsals and performances by students and teachers, workshops and masterclasses featuring visiting musicians, as well as being an attractive space for hire by community music groups. The venue, with its level access, raked seating and flat floor stage, will also lend itself to visual art exhibitions, youth theatre and business conference presentations.

MEMORIAL AND TRIBUTE GIFTS

The Conservatorium welcomes gifts that celebrate and remember others. For example, a donation of:
